Namring Estate in Darjeeling, India. Beautiful flavor with a delicate, flowery finish.

ling with the characteristic flavor of muscat. Unusually large green leaves with lots of tips and a golden color in the cup.

re full-bodied Darjeeling brews a deep golden liquor.

rdens in Sri Lanka. Long attractive leaves, exquisite flavor and subtle body. Excellent afternoon tea.

ast with a beautiful golden color in the cup.

make this most sought after grade. It has a wiry leaf and a high percentage of tips, producing an exquisite liquor and rich taste.

vince in China. Full-bodied with a light, toasty taste. *A classic*.

Brews a rich amber color. Smooth flavor with a subtle orchid aroma.

Yunnan plateau of southern China, produced for 1700 years. Red-amber, bright and full-bodied with an elusive floral aroma.

ovince, this fine black tea is smooth and slightly sweet with no astringency. Beautiful amber color in the cup.

large attractive leaves with lots of golden tips. Full-bodied with a rich, lingering taste.

and a beautiful amber color liquor. The tea leaves are plucked when the tips are still white, thus the name "white tip tea."

leaves with an abundance of golden tips. Brews a light golden brown cup, very smooth with a distinctive yet mellow smoky taste.

an Yin along with its characteristic lovely finish. Grown from hybrid bushes of Orchid Oolong and Ti Kuan Yin.
